



SMT65 brings a new speaker option for tournament style boats. Designed from many of the same building blocks of its big brothers (S7HD/9) the SMT65 is another top of the line solution for boat owners wanting outstanding wake sport performance music on the tower.

SMT65 features powerful 6.5" mid bass woofer coupled to a high output 25mm Titanium dome tweeter. The SX clamping system is a fixed position mount that will fit on most towers right out of the box. It's design covers the speaker cable under the clamp for a seamless factory look.

SMT65 speakers include: 2 speakers / 2 clamps
Power Handling: 125W rms / 250W peak
Tweeter: Fixed 26mm Titanium Dome
Features: Injection Molded Polypropylene Cone, weather proof rubber surround, powder coated water resistant basket and composite hybrid grill throat.


